

ESTATE GARDENS



The Round Pond Estate gardens sprung from a family tradition of growing organic fruits and vegetables in the family's private gardens. Today, the winery garden supplies produce to both the winery and olive mill kitchens. "We understand the importance of providing quality food with quality wines and olive oils, that's why we've chosen to grow our produce onsite using organic methods," says owner Ryan MacDonnell.

The site, located adjacent to the winery, is enclosed with a unique fence made from recycled grape stakes and pine teepee poles, some as tall as 27'. Each bed is double dug and amended with organic compost from the winery. The beds are then hand turned to incorporate organic fertilizers and rock minerals. Water is conserved by using an automated drip system.

Another unique aspect of this garden is the sensory plantings for both Cabernet and Sauvignon Blanc. These garden beds have plantings of fruits, herbs and vegetables that describe the flavors and aromas found in these wine varietals. Along with the descriptor beds there are garden plantings of the vegetables and herbs that have a flavor affinity with Cabernet and Sauvignon Blanc.

"Nothing gives us greater satisfaction than caring for the land, harvesting its bounty, and sharing it with you," says Ryan MacDonnell "We invite you to come by the winery and taste some wine, eat some fresh picked produce and take a tour of the winery and gardens."
